**Minutes of Tuesday, September 12, 2017.**

**I. Call to Order**

Chair, Jeremiah Bryant, PASTACC Chair officially called the meeting to order at 10:06 am

**II. Approval of Minutes**

A motion was made to approve the minutes of the PASTACC meeting on Tuesday, July 11, 2017.

**III. Review of Proposed Changes to PASTACC By-Laws**

Mervin Acebo (AMMA) announced that SBCTA Legal Counsel reviewed the draft by-laws and that changes are reflected in the draft version included in the agenda packet. A clause that states that all PASTACC meetings are subject to the Brown Act is included in the draft. Nancy Strickert (SBCTA) stated that there are other outstanding items that will need to be addressed. The final draft of the by-laws will be presented at the January PASTACC meeting for approval.

**IV. Review of September Unmet Needs Hearing Schedule**

Nancy Strickert announced that the Unmet Needs Hearings are scheduled for September 18, 2017 at the Victor Valley Transit Authority in Hesperia and September 28, 2017 at the Helen Gray Center in the Morongo Basin. She asked that notices should also be posted in areas throughout San Bernardino County where services connect.

**V. Report on SB 1 Legislation and Transit Implications**

Philip Chu (SBCTA) gave a presentation on SB 1 and funding implications on transportation funding for the State. Over \$52.5 billion will be available for transportation projects over the next decade.

**VI. PASTACC Membership Topics**

Nancy Strickert announced that Foothill AIDS and OPARC have been added to the voting membership, replacing the two expired At-Large memberships.

**VII. Omnitrans Highlights of New September Service**

Jeremiah Bryant (Omnitrans) gave a presentation on Omnitrans service updates that began in September. These include Route 61 providing service into Ontario International Airport (ONT), extended weekday service on sbX, tripper service to an Amazon distribution center, and implementation of Token Transit, a mobile phone ticketing payment option for Omnitrans passengers.

**VIII. PASTACC Transportation Network Information**

Dennis Brooks (AMMA) notified the group that he will send agencies an updated Network Card for completion. The Network Card is used to collect contact information from agencies that have transportation needs or concerns. The database is used to notify agencies of transportation related announcements within the county.

**IX. New Annual Report for on San Bernardino County Public Transportation Network**

Dennis Brooks announced that SBCTA will begin drafting a high-level report that presents the transportation performance of the various providers in the county. This report will report across all modes of transportation and will include a summary of accomplishments over the year as well as a prospective look at changes and new projects to come. Comments included:

- Aaron Moore (VVTA) stated that he would be interested in seeing how vanpools will be tracked.
- Mervin Acebo announced that the trips-per-capita measure will also be added as part of the Annual Report. Trips-per-capita measures the consumption of transit use relative to an area's population.
- Jeremiah Bryant stated that in addition to trips-per-capita, staff should consider look at other measures that include vehicle service miles/hours provided relative to the service area size and population.

**X. October Field Trip to VVTA Service Area**

Aaron Moore announced that the VVTA field trip will mimic the Route 15 service. Kevin Kane (VVTA) asked for a head count to see how many people would be interested in attending. Nancy Strickert stated that she will send an e-mail asking who will attend the field trip. Ms. Strickert stated that additional SBCTA staff is interested in attending.

**XI. Operator and Agency Report on Items of Interest to the PASTACC Membership**

Aaron Moore and Kevin Kane reported that VVTA started Route 42 service in Apple Valley to a satellite campus for the college, the Walmart distribution center and the High Desert Juvenile Detention Center. VVTA will continue to implement recommendations from the COA with service changes occurring on October 1. VVTA is also considering a system like Token Transit.

Mark Goodale (MBTA) reported that the Joshua Tree National Park route will begin service on February 1. MBTA also continues to implement service changes from its SRTP and will break ground on several bus stop improvement projects.

Kathy Hawksford and Sandy Benson (MT) announced that they are in the process of looking for land for a new maintenance facility. In addition, the Big Bear Trolley service was extended to October. Mountain Transit is also working with VVTA on its mileage reimbursement program and an effort to provide service into Apple Valley.

Doug Stanley (Omnitrans CTSA) announced that Omnitrans will release a call for projects for Measure I funding in November for the San Bernardino Valley area. The call is for two years of funding with funds available in July 2018.

Jeremiah Bryant announced that Doug Stanley has now moved from interim to permanent Director of Omnitrans CTSA.
