Project Goals

- Explore the mobility needs of older adults, persons with disabilities, persons of low income and military veterans.
- Identify mobility gaps-new and continuing-in San Bernardino County.
- Identify and promote partnerships and new service opportunities to address these gaps.

Authorization

Federal legislation requires the preparation of a locally developed plan that establishes a "unified comprehensive strategy for public transportation service delivery" through a coordinated planning process. This Coordinated plan must be updated every four years. This plan will guide the period 2021 through 2025.

Plan Outcomes

- This Coordinated Plan is necessary for funding eligibility in several grant programs:
 - FTA SECTION 5310- ENHANCED MOBILITY OF SENIORS AND INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES (Funding for transportation needs of older adults and persons with disabilities.)
 - OMNITRANS MEASURE I REGIONAL MOBILITY PARTNERSHIP (RMP) PROGRAM CALL FOR PROJECTS (Funding for transportation needs of older adults and persons with disabilities.)
- It can support the rationale for requests to other grant programs.
- Identifies projects to improve and enhance public transit and specialized transportation.
- Identifies alternative modes and creative opportunities to improve consumers' mobility.
- Proposes partnerships to leverage funds and build new mobility solutions.
- Informs San Bernardino County's public transit operators of mobility needs and gaps to consider in their short and long-range planning.
- Informs SBCTA of regional mobility concerns to help shape funding priorities.
