Ventura County's Freeway Service Patrol (FSP) roams the county freeways to assist motorists at no cost. If a tow truck stops to assist you, please be aware:

- FSP will never charge motorists for service, and drivers will not accept tips.
- FSP operates on certain segments of US 101 and CA-118 from 6:30-9 a.m. and 2-6 p.m. Monday-Friday.
